

Donation from David Wilson Foundation opens up opportunities for young footballers

A donation from The David Wilson Foundation towards brand-new floodlights at the Ashby Ivanhoe Football Club has helped the Club create an Under-18's side which intends to develop home-grown talent for the future.

The Foundation is one of the principal contributors to the floodlights and has made a donation of £15,000 towards the project to improve the ground.
